You will be contacted by FACTS Tuition Management after your registration is complete. All tuition payments must go through FACTS Tuition Management. Your account must be up-to-date for your student to attend class.

Due to adverse impact of semester dropouts on school and teacher finances and planning, a drop policy fee is necessary. You will have two weeks from your child's first day of class to drop a class.

Dress Code

Students and parents should dress modestly.

GIRLS (and women): Shorts for girls and women should be a minimum of 6". No wind shorts are allowed unless worn over leggings that are a minimum of 2' above knee. Yoga pants and leggings **must** be worn with shirts/tops that are at least finger-tip length. (Sweat shirts—even outsized ones--worn over leggings and yoga pants ride up during the day. That is unacceptable.) Skirts should be no shorter than 2" above knees. No spaghetti straps may be worn; no undergarments may be visible. Tops should keep the chest and abdomen fully covered at all times. If you are unsure of what you intend to wear to school, practice sitting, standing, bending over, walking up stairs. **If your undergarments show or show through, your outfit is inappropriate to wear to school.** Girls' parents initial here: _____

BOYS (and men): Boys may not wear tank tops, their shirts should always cover their abdomens (in all positions) and undershirts, and boys' shorts should be a minimum of 6" above the knee.
